DESCRIPTION OF POSSIBLE PLACEMENT ROLE(S) AND ANY PARTICULAR ATTRIBUTES SOUGHT IN A PLACEMENT STUDENT

If you are interested in exploring pastoral ministry with people in challenging situations, a placement with our Chaplaincy Team is for you. There are opportunities in daytime and evenings across Beds, Herts and Bucks, which will suit both on-campus and distance learning students.

You might:

- -support people with complex needs (such as mental health and addictions), through listening support and 1:2:1 mentoring
- -Help facilitate a small group exploring faith, spirituality and life change (such as Journey to a Fuller Life or Church On Thursdays)
- -Offer activities such as arts and crafts, sports, cooking classes, as a way of building relationships
- -Join an existing group of volunteer Chaplains as they offer refreshments, play table-tennis and get to know people in our Hostels or Family centres

Training is offered and we have flexibility of activities and are willing to consider something that would grow and develop your vocation (even if you're not sure what it is yet!) You would be working as part of our Team of experienced staff and volunteer Chaplains.

There are also opportunities to get alongside young people through our Youth Work Team, offering mentoring, supporting youth clubs and other activities. We are happy to put you in touch with the right person if you're interested.

LOCATION AND TRANSPORT OPTIONS:

Nearest location from Campus is in Watford Town Centre (a 10 minute Tube ride from Northwood, followed by a short walk). We have several locations in Watford easily accessible from Northwood by car. If you're a keen cyclist we have a location in West Watford that would suit you!

We have had both on-campus and distance learning students on placements close to where they live across our area. A list of our current locations is below:

We are able to offer expenses to cover fares or mileage (subject to distance limits).

We have locations across Hertfordshire including: Borehamwood, Watford, Abbots Langley, Welwyn, Stevenage, Broxbourne, Ware & Bishops Stortford. Many of which can be reached by public transport or have parking.

In Buckinghamshire our activities are primarily focused in High Wycombe.
