DESCRIPTION OF CHURCH/ORGANISATION/PLACEMENT PROVIDER'S WORK

OM is an international, interdenominational mission organisation based in over 110 countries, and our mission is to see vibrant communities of Jesus followers among the least reached. Our team in Ireland consists of about 35 adults and we work out our mission by Reaching the Irish with the Gospel, Equipping and Mobilising the church. We do so in direct partnerships with local churches, whether through our Big Red Bus ministry and working alongside in direct evangelism, or through providing help in the form of people through short term teams, interns and long term church workers. While Ireland has a rich christian heritage, it's been hurt and oppressed by the religious systems of the Catholic church, and while everyone has heard about God and Jesus, very few have heard the Gospel. It's estimated that about 1,5% of the population in Ireland is a follower of Jesus.

DESCRIPTION OF POSSIBLE PLACEMENT ROLE(S) AND ANY PARTICULAR ATTRIBUTES SOUGHT IN A PLACEMENT STUDENT

DATE: 04/11/2022 We are organising a Big Red Bus tour in spring/early summer of 2023. Our double decker Big Red Bus will travel to different churches across the country, and provide a programme and team of people to minister to that church. Some specific ideas are organising kids clubs, youth evenings, mission mobilising or evangelism training. Time of this would be May-July, but with some flexibility if necessary. We're looking for people that are flexible, team players, good communicators and interested and gifted in missions and/or children&youth work and have a passion to build up local churches. We think this might be great opportunity for your students as they will get experience in cross-cultural living and ministry, will be part of our OM IE family and interact with our staff of whom many have served as missionaries for many years, as well as interact with churches & pastors from different denominations and flavours across Ireland. Students will be part of our normal team life and rhythm, including daily devotions, lunch times, team dinners etc where possible. As they will likely work during the weekends, they will have days off during the week. (working 5 days per week). They might be asked to help in other activities and ministries during their time with us when time allows, from practical work to evangelism.

LOCATION AND TRANSPORT OPTIONS:

Students will stay at Lacken House, our base in the middle of Ireland. We have a guesthouse, with 6 ensuite rooms, a shared kitchen and living room. Students will cater for themselves (or can share this together). There will likely be other guests staying in the house and students might have to share a room. Lacken House is 'in the middle of nowhere', but we've a family and single girl living full time at the base. Students most likely won't have their own means of transport, but staff is available to bring them to the closest town for any of their needs once or twice a week.
