On this trip you will spend a week partnering with and learning from a long-term team in London. You will receive training in cross-cultural ministry and sharing your faith with Muslims, which you will put into practice through joining in with the team's outreach programmes. You will get involved in street outreach under the guidance of experienced evangelists, building relationships and sharing your faith with Muslims. There will also be the chance to learn about the team's work with refugees, and potentially to get involved through helping lead English classes.

You will be spending time together in prayer throughout, lifting up the city and its Muslim residents.



Topics that may be covered in training sessions include how to reach out to Muslims, effective models for street outreach, how to avoid common mistakes and cultural faux pas, and the importance of a relational approach. A mosque visit is also planned, to give you the chance to learn more about Islam and to ask Muslim leaders about their beliefs. Our hope is that you'll come away with a greater heart for sharing the gospel with Muslims in your own context, and better equipped to do so.

Aims

- Learning about Islam and how to share your faith with Muslims
- Receiving training in cross-cultural ministry
- Getting involved in street outreach
- Partnering with and learning from long-term workers
- Gaining a heart for ministry among Muslims
- Gaining vision for how God might be calling you to get involved in His mission

Combining trips

The UK Edge follows on immediately from the North Africa Edge, which runs from 16th – 30th June, giving you the option of taking part in both trips. This would enable you to gain perspective on ministry among Muslims in two very different contexts, with different levels of religious freedom.
