### **DESCRIPTION OF CHURCH/ORGANISATION/PLACEMENT PROVIDER'S WORK**

World Outreach exists to facilitate Christian missionary endeavour with particular focus on evangelising and discipling unreached people groups and equipping them to disciple their own and other peoples. Within this we have a real focus on discipleship, community development and humanitarian aid. So, our goal is not evangelism alone, but, through discipleship and leadership training we seek to enable people groups to disciple their own people and plant their own churches, then go to reach other people with the gospel.

### **DESCRIPTION OF POSSIBLE PLACEMENT ROLE(S) AND ANY PARTICULAR ATTRIBUTES SOUGHT IN A PLACEMENT STUDENT**

There are various placement options within World Outreach and involve projects mainly in the Far East.

These opportunities give great exposure to mission work, a new cultural context and the impact that people can have on others as well as give a life changing experience for the individual on the placement. Our current opportunities entail various focuses including working in schools, sports ministry, outreach ministry to vulnerable women, children and young people as well as a medical project. Further details are outlined here:

#### ALFA LIGHTHOUSE FOUNDATION

Alfa Lighthouse Foundation's football ministry aims to reach young people for Jesus through sports and discipleship programmes. Their vision is to bring life, healing and hope to Kenya's next generation, focusing on young men from Nairobi's slums. They also help the community with monthly food support, a school support programme and have a growing home church.

Opportunity: Teaching English and vocational programmes, soccer ministry and outreach programmes.

Country: Nairobi, Kenya.

#### MOUNT HOPE

Mt Hope in Borneo is a Christian school offering education from kindergarten to high school. The school offers boarding to students. School education is complemented by a training centre that offers training in creating micro-businesses both within the training centre and in the surrounding community.

Opportunity: Teaching English and other subjects. Also open to vocational trainers, plumbers, electricians, builders, bakers.

Country: Indonesia.

#### OUTREACH INDIA

Outreach India runs programmes for children, teenage girls, adult women and mothers that teach Christian values, life skills, health, hygiene and healthy family relationships. Participants are also involved and trained in outreach and house visitation activities.

Opportunity: Teaching English and vocational programmes, outreach programmes.

Location: India.

#### BREATHE LIFE

An opportunity to serve among Rohingya refugees by helping mothers in difficult circumstances give birth safely. Breathe Life are looking for people with a passion and heart for persecuted refugees. As a team member of Breathe Life, you will be supporting Rohingya mothers through providing birth classes, assistance during labour, post-natal follow-up and ongoing support. This work provides unprecedented access and opportunity to build relationships and trust, as we spend time in their homes during the many hours of labour and postnatal visits.

Opportunity: Ideally people with medical or nursing background who can help with birthing families and care of new-borns.

Location: Malaysia.

#### BAAN CHUENJAI

A safe place for underprivileged and marginalised children in Northern Thailand to learn and know Jesus. In Chiang Mai, Thailand, this ministry serves children and families through an after school centre offering tutoring, children's church on Fridays and Bible study at home church on Saturdays. They also build relationships by visiting homes hosting a monthly family night and organise outings to strengthen parent-child bonds.

Opportunity: Teaching English and community outreach

Location: Thailand.

#### CHAENGWATTANA PROJECT

A church planting and discipleship movement in Central Thailand, reaching out to young people and providing hope to the needy through sustainable projects like the Krutmuang Farm.

Opportunity: Teaching English and community programmes, helping out with manual labour around the

farm.

Location: Thailand.

#### RAHAB MINISTRIES

Rahab Ministries reaches out to the women of the red-light industry in Thailand. Rahab aims to share the love of Jesus Christ through friendship evangelism and social concern, provide practical help and emotional support to women working in prostitution, and provide opportunities for education, vocational training and alternative employment.

Opportunity: Join the team and be involved in all their outreach programmes.

Location: Thailand.

#### TOP KIDS MINISTRY

Top Kids Ministry provide a safe place where children from some of the poorest families in Central Thailand can learn English and music, play games, and learn about God's love for them. The ministry runs out of two community houses.

Opportunity: Teaching English, running after school kids programmes.

Location: Thailand.
