The vision and mission of the first UrbanPromise was conceived in a dusty church basement in East Camden, NJ. A small group of college-age missionaries created a summer camp for neighborhood children—providing a safe, loving, fun, and creative place for local youth to escape dangerous city streets. Inspired by a chance meeting with Tony Campolo, Rob Prestowitz began volunteering in Camden and his experience led him to give up his corporate career to found a similar program in Wilmington in 1998: Camp Victory on Wilmington's East Side. UrbanPromise Wilmington now operates 5 neighborhood programs, 2 private schools and an expedition-based learning program.

We are inviting interns to serve with us both now in a year-long role, and during the summer of 2026. This internship offers a meaningful opportunity to grow personally and spiritually through discipleship and mentoring while gaining hands-on experience. Interns will build intentional relationships with youth, families, and peers, serve in neighborhood-based After-School Programs for students in 1st–8th grade, and work alongside full-time and long-term missionaries. Throughout the internship, participants will also develop strong classroom management and leadership skills in a supportive, mission-driven environment.
