DESCRIPTION OF CHURCH/ORGANISATION/PLACEMENT PROVIDER'S WORK

The world needs resilient and empowered disciples of Jesus to listen well, act with compassion, and speak into and shape culture – joining God's restorative work in every sphere of life. LICC exists to make that happen. We want to play our part in seeing God's world transformed for his glory through the impact of whole-life disciples of Jesus.

LICC was established in 1982 by John Stott to help people see the contemporary world through God's eyes and relate the gospel to everyday life. Since then, we've helped hundreds of thousands of Christians in the UK live well as disciples of Jesus in rapidly changing times.

We focus and work across four areas:

- INSPIRE Christians to see how their everyday frontlines matter to God and equip them for fruitfulness
- EMBED whole-life discipling in the life of the gathered church
- HELP individuals understand their culture, grapple with complex issues, and live wisely in our time
- GROW confidence in the Bible, its whole-life relevance, and its practical application

We deliver across the following areas to catalyse a movement of whole-life disciples: resources, courses, events, research, partnerships, speaking engagements, and media appearances.

We're passionate about the emerging generations. We have a strategic focus on empowering those aged 18-35 with the life-giving message that the gospel is relevant to all of their lives. These young people are already major influencers in our culture and implicitly understand that faith should connect meaningfully to everything they do.

DESCRIPTION OF POSSIBLE PLACEMENT ROLE(S) AND ANY PARTICULAR ATTRIBUTES SOUGHT IN A PLACEMENT STUDENT

This placement role can be tailored to the student's interests and calling, involving a blend of opportunities and tasks, but will largely focus in on one of five areas:

- CHURCH: supporting our church team as they connect to and consult with churches, analyse data surrounding existing connections, and create resources to embed whole-life discipling into core gatherings for a range of communities across the UK (point person: Ken Benjamin)
- CULTURE: helping our culture and discipleship team with weekly blogs, developing trainings, and a range of projects to better connect the word of God to the contemporary world in which we're called to live our faith (point person: Dave Benson/Mims Schluter)
- INNOVATION: researching and developing ways in which LICC can ensure the whole-life discipleship vision is compelling to as many young adults as possible, involving evolution of existing resources and creation of new content and channels to expand our engagement with this strategic audience (point person: Tim Yearsley)
- COMMUNICATIONS AND CREATIVE: assisting the teams creating the LICC brand and planning how we share the message of whole-life discipleship through writing, design, video production, marketing, PR, and web and digital platforms (point person: Grete Bauder-Heap)
- OPERATIONS: supporting the day-to-day running of LICC with vital and practical work across our webshop, hospitality, events, festival outreach, and more (point person: Beatrice Henderson)

Our preference is for a weekly placement, spreading the 82-hours over 6 months to a year, so you can be integrated into the wider life and work of LICC. It would require the student to come into the building mid-week to join us physically at St. Peter's, Vere St. (London, W1G 0DQ), ideally on a Tuesday or Wednesday. And there will be an hour of mentoring and Scripture engagement weekly or fortnightly, focusing on becoming a whole-life discipler, with LICC's point person, Dr. Dave Benson (Director of Culture and Discipleship).

We look forward to considering together what form this placement may take, as you continue to grow in your vocation as a follower of Jesus in your particular time and place.
