Musalaha is a faith-based organization that teaches, trains and facilitates reconciliation mainly between Israelis and Palestinians from diverse ethnic and religious backgrounds, and also international groups, based on biblical principles of reconciliation.

Musalaha welcomes undergraduate and graduate students, as well as professionals to work in our office in Jerusalem, and in some cases, remotely. We accept applications on a rolling basis throughout the year, with acceptance based on the applicant's academic performance and the relevant professional background.

Reconciliation Activities: This is a wonderful opportunity to witness reconciliation by preparing for group meetings and spending time with Israelis and/or Palestinians, ranging from children, youth, young adults, and women. (Previous experience preferable.)

In addition to one's specific area of internship, your experience here at Musalaha will give you the opportunity to learn about the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, our approach to reconciliation, and the theological/philosophical principles that inform our work.
